


Manufacturing Offers Diverse Career Opportunities

2019 Manufacturing Day Proclamation

WHEREAS, The County of Jay, Indiana is promoting Manufacturing Day, October 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Manufacturing Day was developed to improve public perception of manufacturing and is supported by thousands of manufacturers as they host students, teachers, parents, job seekers and other local community members at open houses designed to showcase modern manufacturing technology and careers; and

WHEREAS, it is a national celebration of modern manufacturing designed to inspire the next generation on how they can make a difference through manufacturing, give guidance on how to take first steps in starting a career in modern manufacturing, effectively communicate that manufacturiers need the next generation, show students, parents and educators the opportunity, creativity, possibility and accomplishment that comes with a career in manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, with technology advances in manufacturing, career options are now available as never before as more than 25,000 "Baby-Boom" era workers will retire each and every year between now and 2027 in the state of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, approximately 3,000 people are directly employed by manufacturers and generate over \$174,000,000 in earnings within the County of Jay, Indiana; and




